## Membership

Membership in the Honors College is by invitation only. Students with high scores on the SAT, ACT, or FCC placement tests automatically qualify. Applicants with strong academic records (e.g., 3.5 GPA) or faculty recommendations are also eligible. If you are serious about your studies and want to be an active participant in classroom discussions, the Honors College is for you.

## Open Campus Option

High School students may apply for Open Campus membership in the FCC Honors College and join our thriving community.



## How to Apply

- Qualify for Honors through exam or recommendation
- Apply for admission to FCC
- Submit Honors College application and goals survey (recommendation also required for Open Campus students)
- Meet with honors coordinator or an academic counselor to plan your courses and activities

## Requirements

- Maintain 3.0 grade point average or higher (3.5 or higher preferred)
- Complete honors courses (3 credits for Open Campus members; 12 credits for full members)

## Benefits

- Access to the Honors Lounge (H-247)
- Eligibility for honors internships and scholarships
- Graduation from the Honors College with 12 honors credits (3 credits must be at 200 level with research project) with medallion and notation on transcript
- Enhance your application for four-year colleges and scholarships
