<p>- I still do not understand that parents are responsible to pay when the center is closed for any reason. The parent has to pay those days as well as another means of childcare facility or member if they work.</p> <p>- The teachers, administrative staff, etc... are all very nice and helpful! The teachers are constantly communicating with you about your child. They are patient, and you can really tell that they love their jobs and care about what they do! My daughter is learning a lot since she started, and that means the teachers are fantastic!</p> <p>- It would be great if there were more opportunities for infant toddlers to be outside not in strollers</p> <p>- None.</p> <p>- My dissatisfaction with the outdoor areas was resolved, however, I am disappointed I had to figure out for myself that there was poison ivy on YOUR playground, and it wasn't caught earlier by your own staff.</p> <p>- Need more help with potty training. Let children wear pull-up trainers.</p> <p>- Overall I am very satisfied. I wish the program wasn't so expensive for non-students. If it was less expensive I would send my child an extra day.</p> <p>- Please just remind the teachers to leave detailed notes for the parents. They are SO helpful for us! (99% of the time this is ok)</p> <p>- I do not understand why 2% milk is served to the toddler class and whole milk must be provided. The AAP recommends whole milk for all non breastfeeding children under the age of 2. "Whole milk is a good option for toddlers over age 12 months who aren't breastfeeding and who aren't drinking a toddler formula. According to the AAP, in their Guide To Your Child's Nutrition, these 'young children need calories from fat for growth and brain development,' and 'this is especially important in the first 2 years of life.'</p> <p>- I would like to see more opportunities with various materials (playdough, paint, etc.).</p> <p>- none</p> <p>- My only feedback for the children's center would be to offer a multiple child discount. Childcare can get expensive and with multiple children enrolled it would be nice to receive a small discount.</p> <p>- I would really appreciate it if one or more teachers can help the threes class, the head teacher seems always busy and unwelcoming most of the time.</p> <p>- Best childcare around, hands down!</p> <p>- We love the facility</p>

Parents are encouraged to be a part of their child's education.</p> <p>- Provide the right amount of structure for each age group, communicate with parents about what skills and milestones kids are meeting through the parent conferences, generally pay close attention to each child and their needs and interests.</p> <p>- The two-way mirror to see into the child's classroom, but they cannot see you is an excellent and very inventive idea. It becomes very useful and helps to ease parents. The security is excellent as well. I like that you cannot enter the center without a badge or someone physically having to let you in. Keeping a clipboard describing the child's voids and food eaten, time slept. Also, I love how they do an art project to take home, get one almost every week! :) Also, the schedule that is printed out for the next week is very nice. I like knowing what my child will be doing and being exposed to. Even the suggestions to help him out with words and signing.</p> <p>- You fully engage the children. You do everything in your power to actively involve the families. You care.</p> <p>- the sense of concern and security is obvious.</p> <p>- It's a flexible program. The directors are approachable and work with us to meet our needs. I like the lesson plans. The Three's class does a great job of keeping the parents informed and helping them feel involved.</p> <p>- Having 'extra' activities for the kids such as on campus walks, special guests/programs, 'field trip' tour of the school bus, etc. Keeping the kids interested in learning.</p> <p>- The teachers are patient, caring, very nice, and great with the children. My daughter is in Toddling to 2's, and I love that she is learning sign language!</p> <p>- Teachers are great with infants</p> <p>- Pretty much everything! 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10 - What could we do better?

<p>- Nothing. The programs for each age level are outstanding.</p> <p>- The only thing I would like is for the teacher to tell me what my child specifically did that day. The schedule written up the week ahead is perfect and i like it a lot. But i know sometimes because the child is so young, can not always stick to schedule so i would still like to hear what he did that day.</p> <p>- give discounts to FCC Staff..</p> <p>- My only wish is that there was an earlier drop-off time, if only for the nursing students.</p> <p>- The two's classroom needs to work on being more welcoming and engaging the parents when they pick up or drop off. Sometimes a mere wave was all we got upon leaving.</p> <p>- We can't think of anything at this time. We are pleased with the center.</p> <p>- Not really a "better" thing, but would be different. It would be interesting to see more of a structured introduction to some sports skills (eg: ballet, soccer) as a mechanism for team-building, physical coordination, and fitness. Especially with a soccer team at the school who may be able to "mentor" the kids, it would be something that could prove valuable for the children if able to be incorporated into the curriculum.</p> <p>- Nothing at this time.</p> <p>- I honestly can't think of anything - I'm a happy customer.</p> <p>- Give ideas on what to pack for lunch (maybe a workshop or cookbook).</p> <p>- Can't think of anything.</p> <p>- Maybe share a game/activity or other milestone practice that you are hoping to do with the kids that week? That way the parents can carry on the activity/learning at home!</p> <p>- N/A</p> <p>- I would like to see more opportunities for parents to see their students work on display. Maybe an open house to show student skills, songs, etc.</p> <p>The only issue I have had with the Center is the only behavior management strategy is re-direction. Although I appreciate the effectiveness of this strategy it would be nice if they could manage repeated aggressive behaviors, i.e. biting, hitting, differently.</p> <p>- Provide whole milk for toddlers age 1-2. Get the children active and out of the classroom at least once a day if possible.</p> <p>- Lesson plans each week.</p> <p>- Would be very appreciative if some of the teachers can be educated more on how to attend to each child differently, because just like we adults, they have different personality and needs teachers who are willing to aid them.</p> <p>- Communicate concerns about children in a gentle way</p> <p>- everything is perfect</p> <p>- establish a better sick policy. Children with bad colds and excessive congestion are allowed to stay. These symptoms should be treated with the same actions as those for children who are vomiting or have a fever. Germs and sickness are just as if not more easily spread through mucous and coughing.</p>
