KB-100 is equipped with a computer, projector, document camera, Blu-Ray player, Apple TV and an Audio/Visual system with sound. The projection surface is also an interactive whiteboard and can be written on using dry erase markers.

The room is also equipped with a microphone and wall mounted Web camera for virtual meetings.

- The **instructor computer** can be moved for user preference on an adjustable arm.
- If the computer screen is blank, move the mouse to wake it up. If it does not respond, press the power button located on the bottom right side of the computer.
- Log in by typing your network name and password.
- REMEMBER TO LOG OUT WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED.

The controls for the **projector power**, **volume** and **input source** are located on the wall behind the instructor console.

If you wish to connect a **laptop** or other device to the projector, use the **HDMI** cable on the console and press the



HDMI button on the wall controller.

Adapters for most Laptop models are also attached to the **HDMI** cable.

Additional **USB ports** are located on the lower right of the computer as well as the back of the computer screen.


The **Blu-Ray** player is located on the underside of the console top opposite height adjustment handle.

Instructions on how to use the Interactive whiteboard features are on the reverse side of this instruction sheet.

Detailed instructions on how to use the document camera or the wall mounted web camera and microphone for Teams, Zoom or other remote presentations can be found on a separate instruction sheet.

The height adjustment handle can be located on the left underside of the console surface top.

To adjust the height of the console, grasp the adjustment handle and squeeze towards you to release the lock mechanism. You can then raise or lower the console to your desired height.
