Application and documentation should be submitted in PDF form as email attachments.

Required Application and Documentation:

1. Scholarship Application
2. Personal Statement of your educational and career goals
3. Unofficial copies or grade slips from all other colleges and universities attended
4. Résumé or listing of your extracurricular and community activities – Visit FCC's Career Services website for assistance with resume, if needed: <https://www.frederick.edu/student-resources/career-services.aspx>
5. Evidence of your scholarly and creative activities – limit of two items (can include scanned copies of artwork, photos, creative projects, research papers, published material, honors, awards, etc.)
6. One or two letters of recommendation from faculty or staff members at the community college
7. Transcript Release Form allowing FCC to release your FCC transcript to the University System of Maryland Regent Scholarship Committee: <https://app.perfectforms.com/PresentationServer/Form.aspx/Play/WplmAgUI?f=WplmAgUI>
8. Student must submit the FAFSA in order to be considered for any of the Kelly Regents Scholarships or Grants.
