	(GED) General Educational Development <u>Submit</u> a copy of your General Educational Development (GED) certificate.
	Home Schooled <u>Submit</u> a transcript (or the equivalent), signed by the parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses completed by the student and documents the successful completion of a state approved secondary school education program. Frederick County residents must also submit a letter from the home school monitor for FCPS to verify Maryland requirements have been met <u>unless</u> the school is listed on Maryland's approved non-public school list.
	Foreign High School Diploma <u>Submit</u> a copy of your secondary school leaving certificate from the proper government agency or Ministry of Education of the country where you received your education or have your transcript evaluated by a credentialing

service listed below and send the official evaluation to our Welcome and Registration Center:

- The College recommends the use of WES (World Education Services) for the evaluation of your high school education completion.
 - For WES, your evaluation can be requested at www.wes.org. At a minimum, you must request the DOCUMENT-BY-DOCUMENT REPORT. However, if you have college credits, you may wish to request the course-by-course report.
- We will also accept evaluations from other credentialing services provided that the credentialing service is a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services. A list of members is available here: http://www.naces.org/members.html.
