



## For Students Applying to the Evening & Weekend Nursing Cohort

By September 15, 2019

- 1) **Complete Pre-Admission Coursework**: Applicants have through the fall 2019 semester to complete the three (3) science requirements (A&P I, A&P II, and Micro) with a minimum grade of C (higher grades are recommended and important for gaining admission to the Nursing Program), and also as many of the general education requirements as possible, also with a minimum grade of C.
- 2) **Prepare for the TEAS Now**. FCC's Bookstore sells a TEAS prep book and Courtney Sloan in the Learning Commons (Linganore Hall, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, room LC218) runs free drop-in TEAS Prep Workshops where she provides study materials, teaches test-taking strategies, helps students develop a study plan, and more. Summer 2019 TEAS Prep Workshops:
  - June 20<sup>th</sup> 2 – 3 pm
  - July 10<sup>th</sup> 5 – 6 pm
  - August 7<sup>th</sup> 10 – 11 am
- 3) **Take the TEAS** on one of the dates below at FCC's Testing Center and earn a qualifying score: Minimum proficient overall (58.7%) with a minimum reading score of 69%. Both scores must be earned on the same test. Sign up to take the TEAS at FCC's Testing Center through [atitesting.com](http://atitesting.com) starting June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - 7/23-7/25 at 9am and 3pm
  - 7/26 at 9am only
  - 7/29 at 9am only

**Retake the TEAS** on one of the dates below if necessary to earn a qualifying score. Applicant must wait 30 days to retake the TEAS and must have a qualifying score by September 15, 2019.

  - 9/9 at 9am only
  - 9/10-9/12 at 9am and 3pm
  - 9/13 at 9am only
- 4) **Submit Application** as soon as a qualifying TEAS score is earned, and no later than September 15, 2019. Access the online Nursing Program application through the FCC Nursing website: [Frederick.edu](http://Frederick.edu) > Nursing > Enroll > Number 2 – Apply > Nursing Application. **Applicant must submit a qualifying TEAS score with their Nursing Program application.** The evening & weekend nursing program cohort application will be available starting June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 5) **Take the Math Aptitude Test**. Applicants can call the Testing Center starting September 4<sup>th</sup> to make an appointment for the Math Aptitude Test: 301-846-2522. Test dates: September 25<sup>th</sup> – October 1<sup>st</sup>. The test offers applicants the opportunity to earn up to 2 additional points on their applications. To practice and prepare: [Frederick.edu](http://Frederick.edu) > Nursing > Enroll > Number 3 - Test > Math Aptitude Test to access link to a practice test, conversions to memorize prior to taking the test, and math aptitude test dates. Applicants are welcome to meet with a math tutor in the STEM Learning Center (Braddock Hall B212) for assistance preparing for the math aptitude test.
