

# Pre-Health Professions: Respiratory Care A.A.S.

Application Deadline: June 1<sup>st</sup> \*

1. **Apply to the College:** Apply to FCC and declare Pre-Health Professions Respiratory Care AAS as your major.
2. **Submit Official Transcripts:** Send official college/university and high school transcripts, SAT & ACT scores as well as any CLEP, IB or AP scores to the Records and Registration Office.

*Note that official college/university transcripts should be sent upon application to FCC, and must be received by application due date for Respiratory Care clinical program*

3. **Apply for Financial Aid:** Apply for Financial Assistance – Submit the FAFSA and apply for scholarships.
4. **Complete Placement Tests:** Complete FCC placement tests as needed – Consult with Admissions or Advising.
5. **Complete Pre-Admission Courses:** Complete the following minimum requirement with a grade of C or higher\*

[Science prerequisite: BSCI55 or BSCI150 or CHEM101]  
Anatomy & Physiology I (BSCI201 / BI103)

Completion of additional program requirements (see below) by the June 1<sup>st</sup> application deadline is highly recommended as this adds points to a student's application and makes the student more competitive for admission. All additional requirements listed below must be completed to earn Respiratory Care AAS degree. Additional requirements include\*:

ENGL101 (EN101)  
PSYC101 (PS101)  
Anatomy & Physiology II (BSCI202 / BI104)  
Microbiology (BSCI223 / BI120 or BSCI263 / BI203)  
MATH - MATH120 Statistics or higher  
COMM105 – Small Group Communication  
    or a general education COMM elective and a cultural competence elective  
1- to 3-credit PHED, HLTH or NUTR elective

6. **Complete Job Shadowing:** Complete job shadowing [if available] and have shadowing supervisor submit verification email to [HealthSciencesAdmissions@frederick.edu](mailto:HealthSciencesAdmissions@frederick.edu) by June 1<sup>st</sup> application deadline.

7. **Submit Application to Respiratory Care Program:** Submit online application to Respiratory Care Program once you have finished or are in progress with your final prerequisite requirements.\*

Respiratory Care application can be found at Frederick.edu > Programs > Healthcare > Respiratory Care use the blue Application button.

\* Points on application will be awarded only for pre-admission courses completed with a grade of C or higher prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.
