### 1-15 credits

**Career:** Explore career and major areas - Visit Career Center on campus or online to take career assessments and gather information

**Transfer:** Attend a Transfer Information Session - Visit Transfer Center on campus or online to research college and university options, and to create an individual transfer plan - Visit 4-year college websites.

### 15-30 credits

**Career:** Determine your career path - Declare your academic major and map out your course work with an advisor - Talk with faculty teaching and/or people working in your career of interest

**Transfer:** Map out your course work with a recommended transfer program in mind - Narrow your list of colleges and universities to determine intended transfer institution(s) - Meet with your academic advisor to determine course work required of major at FCC and transfer institutions

### 30-45 credits

**Career:** Begin developing your job search plan - Write your resume, practice interviewing techniques - Gain experience related to career goals via employment, internships, volunteer work, etc.

**Transfer:** Determine transfer application/admissions procedures and deadlines of your intended transfer institution(s) - Explore financial aid and scholarship options at various schools for transfer - Begin drafting your essays for transfer admission applications

### 45-60 credits

**Career:** Prepare for transition into the workforce - Check Career Center website - Attend job search workshops, on-campus recruitment events, and off-campus job fairs

**Transfer:** Ask professors for letters of recommendation for transfer institutions - Write your essays for transfer admission applications - Apply to your top 3 - 5 college and university choices - Check deadlines!
